

EASTOVER TOWN COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING

THURSDAY – JANUARY 27, 2011 at 4:00PM

The Eastover Town Council met in special session at Town Hall to discuss the core business district regarding citizen input and zoning ordinances. The meeting was led by Mayor McLaurin and attended by Council Members Lawrence Buffaloe, Cheryl Hudson, Donald Hudson, Bennie Pearce, and Sara Piland. Mr. Willie Geddie was absent.

Mr. Chuck Furr and Mr. Ron Matysek were in the audience.

Mayor McLaurin called the meeting to order, and discussion followed regarding input from the citizenry through an informal public meeting. It was determined that the Town Manager would contact Matt Rooney from County Planning and obtain a listing of all property owners in the discussed area so that notification could be sent to them. The meeting was tentatively set for Tuesday, February 8th at 7:00PM at the Eastover Community Building. Council Member Sara Piland will contact Salem Methodist Church to arrange to use their facility for backup should we have an overflow crowd. An overview of the Council's vision for development of this area will be presented, and resident input will be solicited. Based on the response from the citizens, the Council will inform the County Planning Department and Planning Board of their intentions regarding future zoning request for this Core Business area.

Motion to adjourn was made by Council Member Cheryl Hudson, and seconded by Ms. Piland. Motion passed unanimously, and the meeting was concluded at 3:34PM.
