MINUTES

Call to order was given by Mayor McLaurin.

Council discussed the interlocal agreement proposed by the County Commissioners regarding distribution of the state sales tax. The proposal calls for a three year extension of the existing Sales Tax Distribution Interlocal Agreement, "except that the initially incorporated area of the Town of Eastover shall no longer be treated as an annexation to the end that only those annexations by the Town of Eastover since its incorporation shall be subject to this agreement". A motion to approve the interlocal agreement was made by Don Hudson, seconded by Sara Piland, and approved by a vote of 4-0.

The Council also discussed HB 150 (Design/Aesthetic Controls) regarding the possibility of asking that Eastover be exempt from this bill. It is not certain at this time if the bill is active, as Rep. Glazier's office said it had been sent to the Rules Committee due to a previous Supreme Court ruling. However, as recently as Friday afternoon, Paul Myers with the NCLM has asked local governments to contact their representatives to try and defeat this bill. The Council instructed the town manager to determine the status of the bill and share this information with the Council before taking further action.

Mr. Pearce then made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Mrs. Piland, and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
